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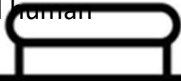

Our Science class will focus on enhancing the following conceptual strands:

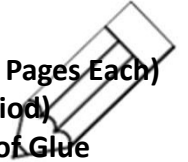
- The structure, properties, and interactions of matter.

- Special circumstances will be taken into consideration and must be discussed and approved by Ms. Stanford.

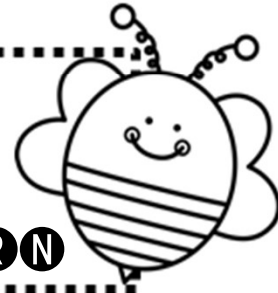


Citizenship Expectations

*What is it?*

Remind provides a safe way for teachers to text message students and to stay in touch with parents for free.

*What makes it safe?*

Teachers never see their student's or parent's phone numbers, Students or parents never see theirs. In this class, Remind is a one-way broadcast system without the reply feature.

*Why use it?*
